

## **International conference**

## **Border disputes after the Great War 1918-1921**

Location: Muzeum Śląska Cieszyńskiego, ul. T.Regera 6, 43-400 Cieszyn (Poland)

Date: 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> August 2021

The conference will address the topic of border disputes in the process of restructuring European area after the end of the Great War. The event will be held symbolically in the town of Teschen (Cieszyn, PL), the former capital of the historical duchy, split by the river between two newly formed states as a consequence of such border dispute. Speakers will be financially rewarded and selected papers will be published in the museum journal.

The event is a part of the project of the Silesian University in Opava (CZ) and the Museum of Cieszyn Silesia in Cieszyn (PL) financed by the grant no. 22010278 of the International Visegrad Fund.

## **Topic areas:**

- Forming of identities in the peripheries of historical lands (creating of bond with national body, irredentism, autonomism)
- Concepts of territorial and legal claims (historical rights, right of selfdetermination)
- Dispute solutions (armed conflicts, plebiscite, international arbitrage)
- Social and economic aspects (economic interests, business and traffic bonds etc.)
- International intermediation (international commissions, allied peace-keeping force etc.)
- Post-war violence (paramilitary units and their activities, terrorism)
- Propaganda
- The problem of new border demarcation
- Afterlife (monuments, forms of remembrance, stigmas)
- Parallel historiographical narrations
